I. INTRODUCTION

Acute diseases are those that have a sudden onset, a rapid course, and a relatively quick completion. They are caused by the temporary explosion of latent psora by an exciting source. The suffering has a set length and is always mild. Acute illnesses end in healing or death on their own without the use of medication. They are further separated into three categories: epidemic, sporadic, and individual acute disorders. Individual acute diseases are those that occasionally strike a single person and present with a variety of symptoms brought on by an external factor, such as excitement, overcooling, or overheating.

The conditions that give rise to disease and the factors that alter it are known as modalities, and they are intimately associated with the cause. The best medication cannot be selected while they are unknown because they personalize and define each illness as well as the medication. The impacts of posture, varied motions, heat and cold, weather, bathing, washing, becoming wet, and any other modifying factor are all included in this category.

Published many years ago, "A Synoptic key of the materia medica and repertory" falls under the category of current repertories. Its contents and usefulness are so great that no practitioner of the rational healing art should overlook it. The first, second, and third editions were released in 1915, 1916, and 1928, respectively. Dr. Banerjee of Kolkata published the expanded edition a few years after Boger's death in 1935. The first section of the analysis is a brief list that includes the aggravating times, aggravating conditions, and ameliorating conditions. The time-related and causal modalities are provided. The quantity of medications covered by section 489 of the repertory.



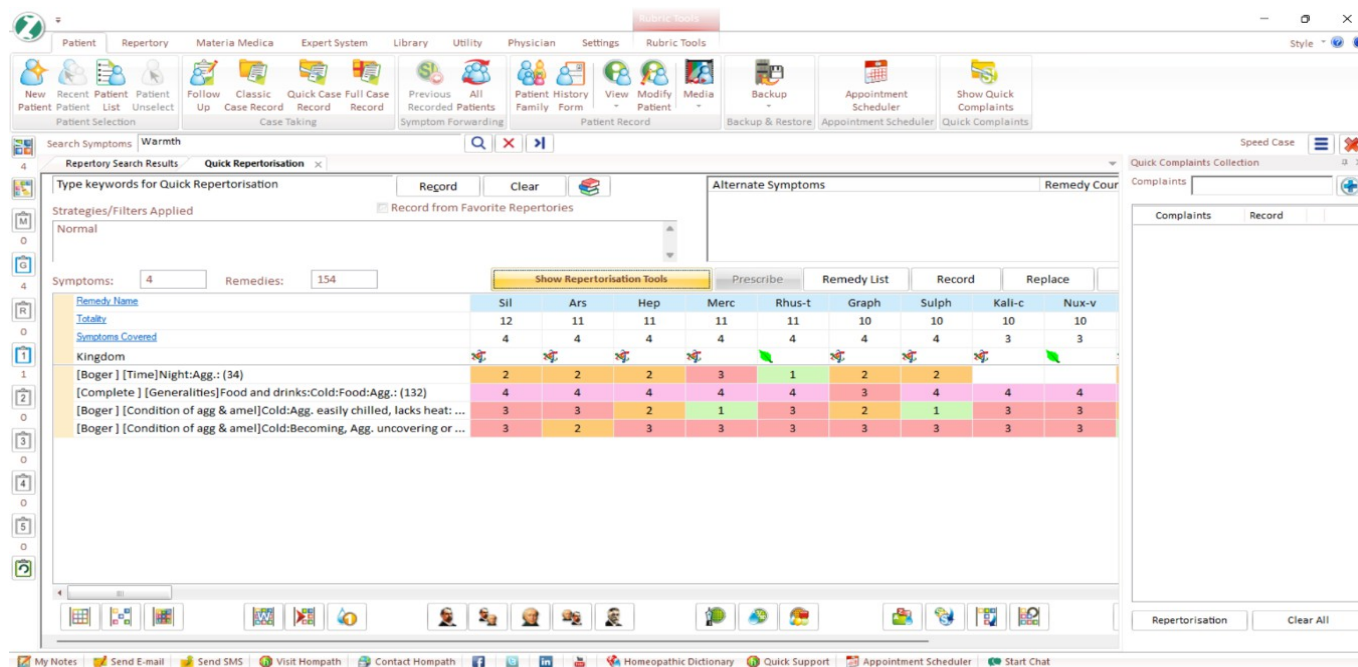

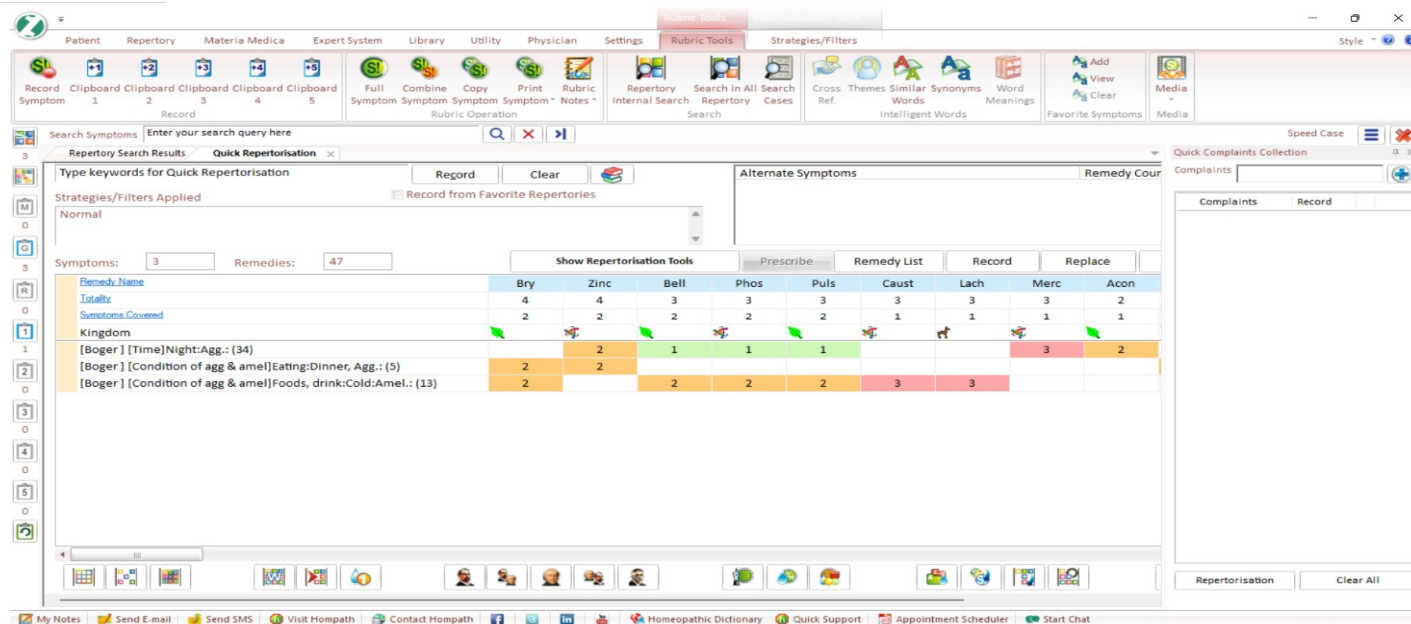
